REGISTRATION COSTS:

Registration fees are **R3 300** per person (there are limited spaces available, i.e. 20-25) and include:

The current prices are R500 per person to Polokwane, but these will be confirmed in May 2020. Interested persons must arrange with Northern Shuttle directly. This is a 3 hour drive so arriving at Jhb International in the morning would be preferable.
