TRAVELLING INFORMATION

TO WORKSHOP IN POLOKWANE:

Recommended:

Flights from OR Tambo International in Johannesburg to Polokwane. Attendants will be transported from airport to accommodation.

Alternative:

Flights to OR Tambo International in Johannesburg (Jhb International) and arrange with the shuttle service – Northern Shuttle (northernshuttlepty@gmail.com) for transport to Polokwane.

The current prices are R500 per person to Polokwane, but these will be confirmed in May 2020. **Interested persons must arrange with Northern Shuttle directly.** This is a three hour drive so arriving at Jhb International in the morning would be preferable.

TO CONFERENCE IN SKUKUZA:

Car rental is available at Skukuza Airport for travelling inside the park.

Alternatively transport can be provided from Skukuza Airport to Skukuza Camp at R100 per person return.

- 1 Flights from OR Tambo International to Skukuza Airport.
- 2 Flights from Cape Town International Airport to Skukuza Airport.
- 3 Flights from OR Tambo International to Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport (Nelspruit/ Mbombela).

This is about 112 km (about 2 hours driving) from Skukuza driving outside Kruger National Park or 136 km from Skukuza driving through Malelane inside the park.

Please note that speed limits in the park is only 50km/h on tarred roads and thus this trip can take between 3 to 4 hours.

Visitors to Kruger National Park should adhere to gate times: During June, entrance and camp gates open at 06.00 and all gates close at 17.30.

No transport will be provided from Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport. Delegates who chose this option have to rent a car at the airport.

- 4 Flights to OR Tambo where car rental is available for travelling to Skukuza. This is about 460km (shortest route) and **will take about 6 hours travelling.**
